Re: Contract No. 1275 Supply of Sodium Silicofluoride (SSF) powder for 2010 onwards.

Thank you for your invitation to tender for Sodium Silicofluoride (SSF) supply. We have pleasure quoting for the continuing supply of Sodium Silicofluoride from April 2010 onwards.

As your current SSF supplier we formally advise you that Greater Wellington Regional Council still has under your rolled over 2009 supply contract with our Principal's, two 20 tonne shipments of SSF outstanding. Maseina Koneferenisi of your Council has indicated that two orders for these FCL's are likely to be placed later this month and about March 2010. So currently this means that at average usage rates, Council is still committed to receive 40 tonnes of SSF which equates to 9 months fluoride supply under this earlier contact. We predict therefore Council is actually unlikely to require further Sodium Silicofluoride until September 2010. Our accompanying quotation however remains being prepared and available to supply SSF from April 2010 onwards.

Our Principal's Sodium Silicofluoride is renowned for its free flowing ability in automatic dosing equipment, does not cake and does not require pre-mixing as inferior SSF is prone to need. Invercargill Council before switching to Prayon SSF last year, experienced numerous problems with an alternative Chinese SSF supply that included caking, yellow discolouration, metal springs, plastic and cardboard in supplied product that frequently blocked their feed mechanisms. Rest assured that Greater Wellington Regional Council can continue to purchase Prayon SSF manufactured to the same highest European standards it has been successfully using for the last seven years.
